Community transport

Public transport in Victoria is now more accessible to people with special needs. For those who are unable to access public transport, Portland Community Health and Heywood Community Transport provide transport for the frail or people with a disability who live independently in the community, but have no means of transport.

What services are available?

Transport is available for people unable to use private or public transport to meet their basic needs, and who require extra assistance due to limited mobility or disability.

Where can I catch them?

The service will pick eligible people up from their home and is available through a booking system. To find out more or to make a booking, call Portland Community Health on 5522 1188, 8.30am – 5pm Mon – Fri or Heywood Community Transport on **5527 0570**, 8.30am – 5pm Mon – Fri.

When do they run?

The services operate seven days a week and are subject to availability.
