Explore Point Nepean using the all-weather hop on hop off shuttle service.

Commencing at the Quarantine Station, the service stops at the start and finish of all the scenic walks between there and Fort Nepean.

Visit the cemetery and Gunners Cottage. Get up close and personal with the unique flora and fauna. Walk along dramatic cliff-top paths with breathtaking views of Bass Strait and Port Phillip overlook the beach where Prime Minister Harold Holt went missing. Explore the military fortifications which date back to the 1880s.

One way from the Information Centre/ Quarantine Station to Fort Nepean is 4km and from Gunners Cottage to Fort Nepean is 2.7km.

Get on the Bus


The hop on hop off shuttle bus service makes Point Nepean National Park more accessible for everyone. Running continuously from the Quarantine Station to the Fort Nepean and back again with stops along the way, you can choose to walk part of the distance, specific sections of it, or just enjoy the stunning views from the comfort of the bus while listening to informative commentary.

- One ticket entitles holder to unlimited travel on the shuttle bus for the entire day.
- Tickets are purchased from the driver. Cash and most credit cards are accepted. EFTPOS available.
- The shuttle bus goes to Ventura 788 route service bus stop at the front entrance gate which runs from Frankston Railway station to Portsea, on selected runs (see timetable below).
