Local buses

What services are available?

Kings Coach Lines (Colac Transit) operate regular town bus services for Colac and surrounds Monday to Saturday. Coles Coaches operates an intertown service from Warrion / Alvie to Colac Monday to Friday. These bus services connect you to Colac Railway Station for V/Line services.

Where can I catch them?

The following pages include detailed maps of the Colac town service bus routes and timetables from Monday – Saturday with Kings Coach Lines (Colac Transit) and Monday – Friday intertown service with Coles Coaches.

When do they run?

On weekdays, Colac Town Service buses run to and from the station connecting with V/Line services to Melbourne, Geelong and Warrnambool. V/Line coaches

There are a number of coach services that take you to destinations across Victoria. To plan your trip, use the online journey planner at **viclink.com.au** or call **136 196**.

What coach services are available?

V/Line coach services to Ballarat and the Great Ocean Road run from Geelong. Coach services to Port Fairy, Heywood, Hamilton, Casterton, Ballarat and Mt Gambier run from Warrnambool.

Where can I catch them?

Take the train to Geelong or Warrnambool stations to connect with your coach service. Check the timetable ahead of travelling for a smooth connection.

When do they run?

For V/Line coach service timetables, visit **vline.com.au** or call **136 196**.

What are the fares?

V/Line trains

V/Line runs daily train services between Warrnambool and Melbourne, passing through the Colac area.

What train services are available?

V/Line trains run from Geelong and Warrnambool to Melbourne. Reservations are required.

Where can I catch them?

V/Line trains can be boarded at Colac, Camperdown and Birregurra stations. See maps for location.

When do they run?

Trains to Melbourne from Geelong and Warrnambool run frequently on weekdays and weekends. For full timetables refer to the enclosed timetable booklet in the front of this brochure, visit **vline.com.au** or call **136 196**.

Community transport

Public transport in Victoria is now more accessible to people with special needs. For those who are unable to access public transport, Colac Otway Shire and Corangamite Shire provide community transport services for the frail or people with a disability who live independently in the community, but have no means of transport.

What services are available?

Transport is available for people unable to use private or public transport to meet their basic needs, and who require extra assistance due to limited mobility or disability.

Where can I catch them?

The service will pick you up from home and is available through a booking system. To find out more or to make a booking, call Colac Otway Shire on **5232 9420**, 9am – 4pm Mon – Fri or Corangamite Shire Community Transport Service on **5593 7100**, 8.30am – 5pm Mon – Fri.

When do they run?

Services run Mon – Fri and are limited in availability. It is essential you make an early booking to use these services.

What are the fares?

A fare or donation may apply. Please check with the Community Transport Coordinator when making your booking.

What services are available?

Colac Active Taxis, Camperdown Cobden Taxis and Apollo Bay Taxi Service provide services for everyone in the community. Colac Active Taxis have a maxi taxi that is licensed for up to eight passengers and is wheelchair accessible.

Where can I catch them?

When do they run?

Colac Active Taxis, Camperdown Cobden Taxis and Apollo Bay Taxi Service operate a 24-hour service, seven days a week.
