## City Circle Tram extension

The City Circle Tram route has been extended to show you even more of Melbourne's best attractions.

The route now extends to Melbourne's Docklands precinct – the exciting new entertainment, recreation and residential hub right next to the CBD, offering waterfront cafés, restaurants, bars, shops and water-based activities. The extension to the route also provides faster and easier access to the Telstra Dome – Melbourne's new venue for AFL matches.

The extension of the route means that the frequency of the City Circle Tram service will change from 10 minutes to 12 minutes.

A new brochure listing the attractions and the City Circle timetable will be available soon from the Melbourne Visitor Centre at Federation Square, the Met Shop and on all City Circle Trams.



## Getting around town

The City Circle Tram service provides a free and convenient way to get around central Melbourne. Tourists, shoppers, office workers and families can use the City Circle Tram to travel to major attractions, shops and city activities.

The City Circle Tram travels around the city and links with other tram, train and light-rail routes in and around Melbourne. It will take you past shopping malls, arcades and major attractions such as the Old Treasury Building, Parliament House and the Princess Theatre.
